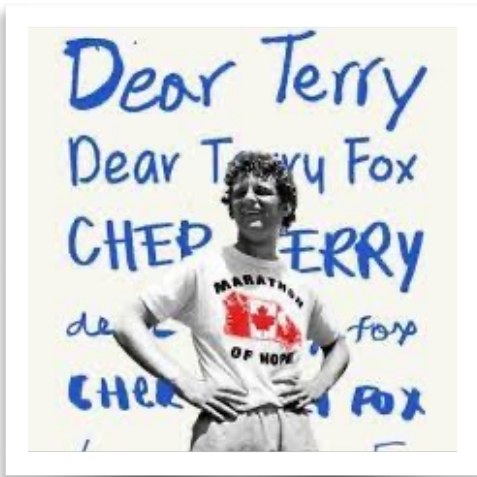

Students will be participating in a school-wide Terry Fox Run on Sept. 28. Donations for cancer research can be made online to the Terry Fox Foundation:

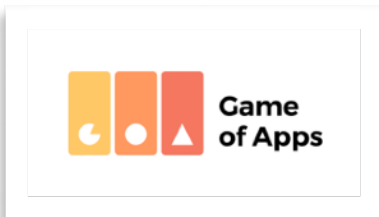
