Student Drop Off and Pick Up

As a smaller school, Maple Lane does not have the same drop-off and pick-up challenges as larger schools. However, the school has grown in recent years and the driving circle and parking lots do get busy at times. Here are a few key reminders:

- Whenever possible, please try to use alternate forms of transportation to and from school, such as walking or cycling. This will reduce congestion and teaches children the health and environmental benefits of going car free.
- The parking loop is for drop-off and pick-up only. Please do not park your car and leave it in the loop.
- Please go idle free and turn off your engine while waiting.
