Student Safety: Traffic in Parking Lot

We have noticed a recent increase in traffic in the school parking lots and the driving loop. We encourage families to use other forms of transportation (e.g. walking and biking) to enter the school grounds in order to reduce congestion and increase student safety. This also frees up space to meet the mobility needs of all of our community members.

Here are a few important reminders

- The driving loop is for immediate drop off and pick up. Please do not park in this loop. We encourage families to park on Tweedsmuir and walk into the school grounds.
- The inner lane of the driving loop is for through traffic. It is not safe to drop off or pick up from this lane.
- Please note the accessible parking spots and leave these open for those who need them.
- Please remember to follow BC idle free laws and turn engines off.

We greatly appreciate the cooperation of our community as we work towards safe and efficient drop off and pick up of students.



Spotlight on Viola Desmond

Viola Desmond was born in 1914 in Nova Scotia. She was a Canadian civil rights activist and businesswoman who mentored young Black women in her Desmond School of Beauty Culture. In 1946, she challenged racial segregation at a cinema in New Glasgow, Nova Scotia by refusing to leave a whites-only area of the Rosalind Theatre. In 2018, Viola was named a National Historic Person by the Canadian government and is the first Canadian woman to be featured on a banknote. She is on the \$10 bill. Students can learn more about Viola Desmond and other prominent Black Canadians by visiting our library and our Equity, Diversity and Inclusion bulletin board.
