Student Safety: Traffic in Parking Lot

We have noticed increased congestion in the parking lot at drop off and pick up times. Here are a few gentle reminders about the use of our parking lot:

- Please note the **accessible parking spots** and leave these open for those who need them.
- Please remember that **the drop off loop is for immediate drop off and pick up** and should not be used as a parking spot.
- Whenever possible, **please try to use options other than driving** to transport your children to and from school (e.g. walking, biking etc.). This will help clear up congestion and make the parking lot safer for everyone.
- **If you can, please park on Tweedsmuir** and walk the rest of the way to the school. This frees up parking spaces for those who really need them (e.g. families with small children and people with mobility challenges)
