Walk 'N' Wheels Wednesdays Every Wednesday in May

On May 20, we had our third Walk 'N' Wheels Wednesday. We made another slight increase in active transportation participation. We went from 75% to just over 76%. Students received an extra 5 minutes of recess as a reward. Our goal this week is for even greater participation. If the school gets to 85%, students will have 10 extra minutes of recess and if we get to 95%, they will get 15 extra minutes. Please remember that for anyone travelling on wheels, a helmet must be worn for safety. For students who live too far to walk or bike, they can park outside of the school grounds and walk the rest of the way.

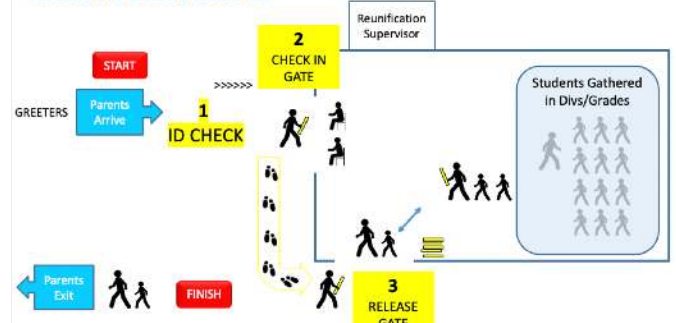


Evacuation Drill and Emergency Procedures Practice - May 26

Maple Lane will be conducting an evacuation drill and emergency procedures practice on Tuesday, May 26, at 1:00pm (back up day is June 3). We are giving families a heads up so that they do not think there is an actual emergency taking place. Our plan is to evacuate the building and then set up the area as we would for a regional emergency. We will set up a command centre, a first aid tent and the checkpoints for student reunification (see image to the right). The purpose of this drill is to provide team leaders an opportunity to practice their role and for students to learn more about what we would do in an emergency situation. We will not be doing the full reunification process, but a graphic has been included to show how a student-family reunification would take place. In the case of an actual emergency, a systematic process would be used to ensure that students are reconnected with their parents/guardians and we are able to record who students have been picked up by and where they are going.
