1) Daily Health Check

2) Reporting and Communicating Student Learning

This school year, <u>all teachers</u> will be using the same written format for communicating student learning. There will be five communication events: Four learning updates (two written and two conferences) and one written Summary of Learning at the end of the year. We will have our first parent-teacher conferences next week. Your child(ren)'s self-assessments on the core competencies will continue to be posted in their e-Portfolio. For some teachers, they may continue to use e-Portfolios to provide windows into learning throughout the school year as well.

3) **FSA's:** Students in Grade 4 & 7 will be participating in the Foundation Skills Assessment (FSA) this month. Each year, the Ministry of Education requires school districts to conduct this province-wide assessment and is designed to see how students are progressing in the foundation skills of Reading, Writing, and Numeracy. We know this is one assessment and only gives a snapshot of your child's learning. As a school, we use this information to further learn about your child(ren) and gives us more information about their learning.
