Spring Activities: Pack Extra Snacks (if you can)



Spring is an active time for students. The weather leads to more outdoor play and they are engaged in KM Run, track and other activities. They are also growing and sometimes need extra food to make it through the day. This is a good time to talk to your children about whether they are bringing enough food to make it through each day. You can involve them in packing their lunch and snacks.

At Maple Lane, we have a community fridge and a snack drawer that students can access when they need some extra food. This can be for a variety of reasons such as forgetting their lunch at home, or finishing their lunch and still being hungry. A very important reason for us to have the community fridge is to help support families who benefit from accessing the fridge as a supplement to the food they are providing from home. We are continuing to teach students how to differentiate between wants and needs. Students should be thoughtful about how they access the fridge so that we have enough food for those who need it. This week, we had a lot of students access the fridge and we have run low on supplies. We will restock and continue to provide food for those who need it.
