Principal's Report

- **Acknowledgment of First Nations Territories.**
- **Green Team:** The Green Team is working on an initiative to educate students about carbon footprint by reducing heat consumption. This will be achieved by lowering the indoor temperature at the school by 2 degrees Celsius on one day.
- **Hip Hop Dance:** Scheduled for the week of January 19th. Parents are welcome to join at 2pm on January 23rd.
- **Basketball Season:** Practices have started, and game schedules have been set. Parent drivers are required to do criminal background checks.
- **Gateway Theatre:** The field trip has been confirmed for April 29. School buses have been booked.

Chair report

- **Movie night:** The movie Shrek will be shown on January 30. The flyer will go out shortly. Gr 7 students will run the candy concession.
- **Spring Fling:** The PAC has decided not to host the Spring Fling for this school year. In the February meeting, we will consider other smaller events for the end of the school year or at the beginning of the next school year in September.
- **Community celebration grant:** The deadline to apply is February 8, 2026. The grant is available for events that take place after June 1, 2026. The events need to be open to the community and free of charge.
- **Bubble tea fundraising:** Decided not to go ahead with this idea.

- **Other fundraising:** We will look into hosting a garage sale at the school parking lot in June.

Treasurer's Report

- **General Account** – balance on December 31 was about \$34,400. After clearing approved payments, deposits, and budgeted event payments, the balance will be approximately \$17,540.
- **Gaming Account** – current balance is about \$16,816. After payments for the budgeted activities, the balance will be around \$4,276.

Update and Follow Up

- Reading activities: School staff all agree to promote reading interest among students. However, staff do not support associating monetary rewards with reading activities. Neal will discuss further with the staff and circle back in the February meeting.
