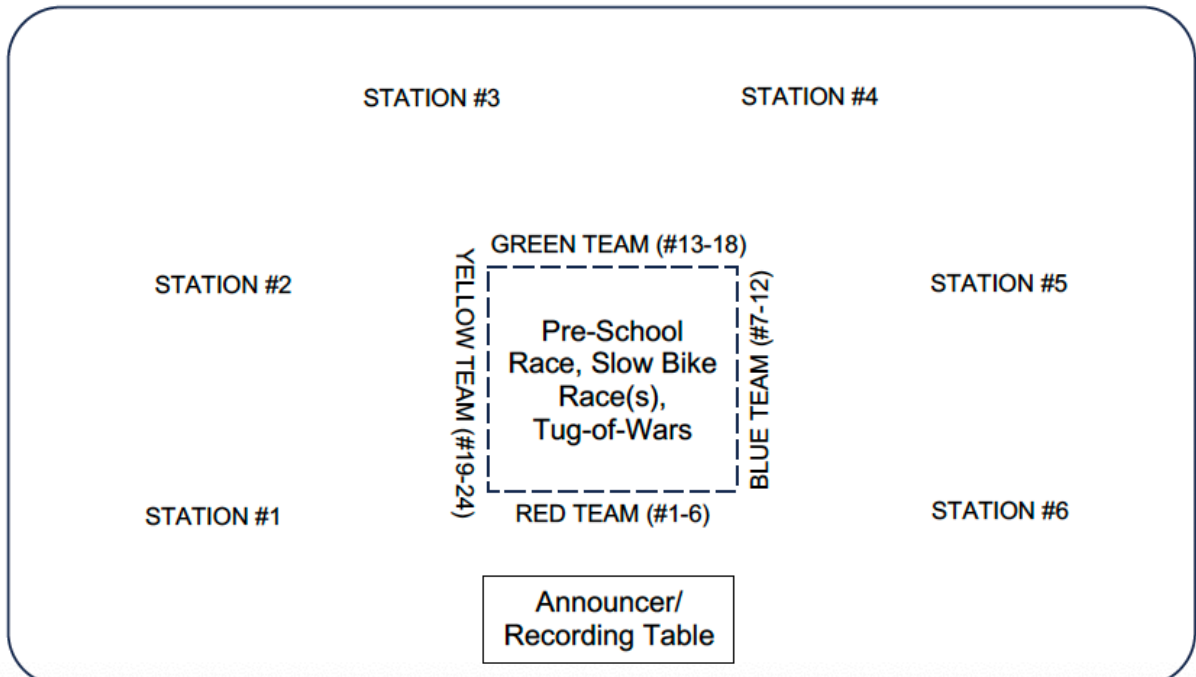
Please see below for some important information about the day:

- **Parents and Families** – Parents and families are welcome to attend our events outdoors if the weather is nice.
- **Rain Contingency Plans:** If the weather is poor, Sports Day will be indoors. Stations will take place in the gym, library, and 2 open classrooms. Cheers and tug-of-wars will take place in the gym.
- **Outdoor Picnic Lunch**
 - Lunch orders will be delivered to the classrooms at noon.
 - Students pick up their lunches, then go back outside to eat picnic style.
- **Bike/Scooter Parade** – If students would like to participate in a bike/scooter parade, please remind them to decorate their bikes/scooters. All children participating in the parade must wear a helmet. Storage upon arrival at school in the morning will be in the coned off area nearby the team colour. This will be supervised by a non-enrolling teacher as of 8:30am so that students can leave their bikes/scooters there and access them easily for the parade. After the parade, they will be stored and locked up in the bike racks until the end of the day.
- **Slow Bike Race** – intermediate students are welcome to take part in an optional slow bike race. Helmets are required. The last one to cross the finish line without putting their feet down wins!
- **Pre-School Race** – Preschool aged children are welcome to participate in the pre-school race that is scheduled at 9:30am. The Little Maples Preschool will also join us.
- **Early Dismissal** – Our Sports Day events will end at 1:30pm, at which time parents are welcome to take their child(ren) home for the day. The PAC raffle will take place at 1:30pm, shortly after students are dismissed.
- **Parent Appreciation Station/Tent:** coffee and treats for parents/guardians. Staff will provide homemade treats/snacks as a thank you to our parents/guardians.
